Port Coquitlam Forklift Operator Training - Lift truck training is a prerequisite within North America and is intended to prevent workplace injuries and death. Lift truck training provides driver training meant for forklift operators. Training programs teach the effective and safe operation of forklifts. Training sessions are tailored for different working settings, such as enclosed stores or outdoors on a construction site. Course content includes everyday inspection procedures and safety protocol. Trainees learn the way to maneuver in a populated work environment.

When operated by an inexperienced person, a forklift could be very dangerous. In order to reduce the possibility of accident, potential operators must go through forklift training by a certified instructor before using a forklift. All parts of lift truck handling are included in training programs. The limitations and abilities of the machine are covered, along with essential operating procedures, pre-operation inspections and methods of warning other staff that a forklift is in the work area.

Lessons include the placement of the trailer tires and chock blocks, the arrangement of pallets to be able to spread out the load right, and inspections required prior to driving into a trailer at a dock site. Courses also comprise Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Even if not related directly to the operation of a forklift, MSDS training is vital if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the proper methods of handling spills, the products and their effects on people.
